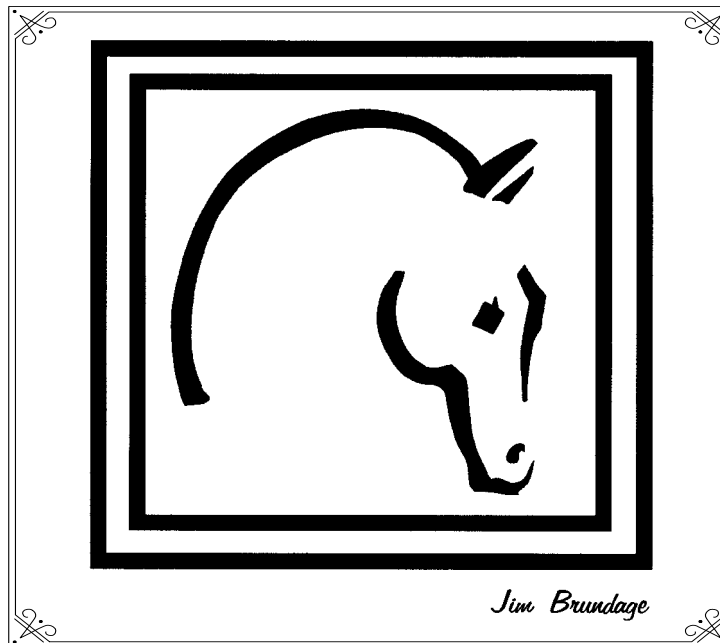

HUNTER DIVISION

“EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.”

Hunter sections may be run as back-to-back classes at management's discretion. When classes are run back-to-back, exhibitors may perform both rounds before leaving the ring.

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, panels.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Horses will not be jogged for soundness unless otherwise noted. Judges will reflect any unsoundness in their scores.

All Hunter Championships Classes: Awarded to the top two of the top four horses/ponies, which have earned the most points in over fences classes. In addition to these points, only these top four horses/ponies will receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle class. In addition, Full points will be earned in the Regular Conformation Model class and half points in the Green Conformation Model class, and the Small, Medium, Large & Green Pony Model classes.

Jumping Order: Jumping order will be established in accordance with the USEF rule - HU 158.

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career.

REGULAR WORKING HUNTER SECTION

A Regular Working Hunter is a horse of any age not restricted by previous showing in any division. In classes over fences, horses to jump 4' minimum. All classes to be judged on performance and soundness. To be jogged. Last over fences class in division is New Marshall & Sterling League qualifier.

GREEN WORKING HUNTER SECTION

A Green Hunter is a horse of any age that is in his first or second year of showing in any classes, at Regular Member Shows or Eventing Competitions of USEF or Equine Canada or any national or international competition in any classes that require a horse to jump 3'6" or higher. When shown in a Green Section a horse in his first year of showing must be shown as a First Year Green Horse and a horse in his second year of showing must be shown as a Second Year Green horse. In classes over fences, first year horse to jump 3'6" and second year horses to jump 3'9". To be jogged. May be combined if there are six entries or less in any divided section. Last over fences class in division is New Marshall & Sterling League qualifier.

A Green Hunter is a horse of any age that is in his first or second year of showing at Regular Member Shows or Eventing Competitions of USEF or Equine Canada or any national or international competition in any classes that require horses to jump 3'6" or higher. Horses are to jump 3'6" or 3'9" for their respective section. To be judged on 60% performance, 40% conformation. Model class to count ½ points. To be jogged. Last over fences class in division is New Marshall & Sterling League qualifier.

Entry Fee: \$140 for the section. \$10 additional for the Model.

REGULAR CONFORMATION HUNTER SECTION

A Regular Hunter is a horse of any age and is not restricted by previous showing. Horses are to jump 4'. To be judged on 75% performance, 25% conformation. **Model class to counts full points toward championship.** To be jogged. Last over fences class in division is New Marshall & Sterling League qualifier.

Note: If the Regular and Green Conformation sections are offered and there are less than 3 entries in either Conformation Section, they must be combined. Combined sections are to be judged 60% on performance, 40% on conformation. If a horse is eligible for more than one section, the exhibitor must declare to the show secretary which height section the points are to count toward.

PRE-GREEN HUNTER SECTION USEF “C” RATED

Open to a horse that has not shown over 2'9" in any class at Regular member competitions or Eventing Competitions of the Federation or Equine Canada or any national or international competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, way of going, and suitability as a hunter. Horses may be jogged for soundness at management's discretion. Pre-green Hunter may be offered in two height sections: 3' and 3'3". If only one height is offered, it must be 3'. Height sections may be combined in one division with both heights offered. A horse may only exhibit in one height section at a given show. A Pre-Green hunter is eligible for two competition years from the time it first competes in a USEF Pre-Green Hunter class as a 5 year old or older; a horse competing in the Pre-Green Hunter as a 4 year old or younger is eligible to compete for two years once it competes as a 5 year old or older. A horse competing in a Pre-Green class may not compete in a class with fences over 3'3" at the same show. Zone awards will be presented annually. **Please provide the level at which the horse is competing for eligibility and awards**

purposes. Class 104, 143 is the New Marshall & Sterling League qualifier. Note: Sections will be combined if there are six entries or less in any divided section.

AMATEUR OWNER WORKING HUNTER SECTION

To be ridden by Amateur Owners or an amateur member of the owner's family. In either case classes are restricted to riders who are no longer eligible to compete as junior exhibitors. Leased horses are not eligible and multiple ownership is not permitted unless all owners are members of the same family. An amateur who rides for a person outside the family may not ride in a class restricted to Amateur Owners in the same show. Horses may not cross enter into the Adult Amateur Hunter Division at the same show. Fences 3'3" and 3'6". To be jogged.

Note: Sections may be combined if there are eight (8) entries or less in any divided section.

Champion and Reserve Champion qualify for USEF Junior Hunter National Championship. May be combined if there are four entries or less in any divided section.

Classes limited to ponies 14.2 hands and under and riders who have not reached their 18th Birthday. No pony may be shown in a performance class in this division unless the owner possesses a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by the Federation. Management MAY NOT issue exhibitor numbers until the above requirements have been complied with. Manners and suitability of a pony for a rider shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Suitability of pony for a rider shall be determined by the height and weight of the rider in relation to the size of the pony as well as the compatibility of the rider and pony. No rider may show more than three ponies in any one height section. To be jogged. Note: If there are four or more entries in any divided section, the sections will be held separately.

Open to ponies 12.2 hands and under. Fences – 2'3". No juniors over the age of 12.

Open to ponies of any age that have not been shown over fences in regulation height or higher for their respective section at a Regular Member Show of this Federation or CEF prior to December 1st of the previous year. Once a pony has broken its green status in one section, it shall not regain its status by moving into another section. Small ponies to jump 2'3", medium ponies to jump 2'6", and large ponies to jump 2'9". To be jogged. Requirements are the same as PONY HUNTER, with the exception of age of the rider. Riders under 18 years of age may show any size green pony.

Horses and ponies exhibiting in this division may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Adult Amateur Hunter. Fence heights 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Adults may ride ponies, suitability to count.

Note: Younger and Older Adult Amateurs may be combined if there are less than eight entries in either section.

Horses and ponies exhibiting in this division may cross enter multiple sections of Children's hunter and any classes where eligible. To be judged in performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, with suitability of child's mount stressed. Fence heights 3'; spreads not to exceed height of fence.

Note: Younger and Older Children's may be combined with less than eight entries in either section.

Open to ponies ridden a junior exhibitor with no other age restrictions applicable. Riders may ride one pony at 2' and/or one pony at 2'6" of the Children's pony section when also competing in the Regular small, medium, or large pony sections. Riders may cross enter into the Green Pony Division. Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3". Exception: may show in Pony Jumpers. Ponies exhibiting in Children's pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible. Ponies cannot be cross-entered into the rated Regular, Green Pony and Children's Hunter Pony sections at the same competition. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going and size of rider to mount with suitability of children's ponies stressed. Ponies will not be jogged for soundness. Small and medium ponies to jump 2', and large ponies to jump 2'6". Spreads not to exceed the height of the fence.
